You are invited to submit an abstract for the above conference.

The Panel for Biomedical Engineering organises this biennial, multi-disciplinary meeting to attract the best young engineers and scientists from throughout the UK. The meeting provides a unique forum for early-career researchers to showcase their work with opportunities for mentoring and guidance on scientific and professional opportunities from selected experts. The aim is to encourage feedback, promote collaboration between the delegates and explore new ways of doing things.

This year's meeting will focus on medical imaging and interventions in cancer. Sessions will include **emerging imaging techniques, image guided radiotherapy, image guided surgery and intervention, robotics and smart instruments** and **clinical and industrial translation**. There will also be a career development workshop with guidance on academic and non-academic career pathways.

The conference is targeting post-doctoral researchers. However, we may be able to accept exceptional PhD students. PhD students are welcome to apply but please bear in mind that the organisers will prioritise applications from post-docs.

Places at the event are strictly limited and based on submission of a short statement as to how the participant might benefit, a short CV and an abstract of their research. Accommodation, meals and registration will be provided free of charge for the researchers selected to attend the event.
